



The Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services is hosting a series of in-person testing opportunities between now and the end of August for individuals with a direct life experience of a mental health or substance use disorder who are interested in becoming a Certified Peer Recovery Supporter. Any individuals who are interested in taking the in-person exam may view available testing dates and locations and register through Eventbrite at <https://www.eventbrite.com/>. Interested individuals should type “Ohio peer” into the search box and “Columbus, Ohio” in the location box to register for the date and time that works best for them.

To participate in the in-person testing, test takers must bring photo identification (either a state driver’s license or state identification card) and a number 2 pencil. Test takers must arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of the exam. Individuals who do not have a photo identification or who arrive late will not be permitted to test. Test takers will have a maximum of 3 hours to complete the exam. As a reminder, individuals who have taken the OhioMHAS Integrated Peer Recovery Supporter training and have passed the exam do NOT need to take this exam (anyone who has tested after August 2013). OhioMHAS is working to finalize an on-line version of the exam and more information will be forthcoming.
