Mark S. Gold, MD



Mark S. Gold, MD, is a translational researcher, author, and inventor best known for his pioneering work on the brain systems underlying the effects of opiate drugs, cocaine, and overeating. His research career started in 1972 and he has

been a prolific author of more than 1,000 academic texts, abstracts, articles and chapters. Dr. Gold is considered the father of the modern neurobiological approach to addiction and also medication assisted recovery. This locus coeruleus theory of opiate and drug withdrawal is a mainstay of 2015 theory and practice, even though he proposed it in 1978.

Johanna O'Flaherty, PhD, is the CEO of Central Recovery Treatment (CRT). Central Recovery's Las Vegas based substance abuse treatment organization (the Las Vegas Recovery Center) that provides a full continuum of care,
