### **Ohio Peer Supporter Facilitator Training January 11-13, 2016**

Qualified candidates must be a peer supporter, have facilitator experience or experience speaking in public, and be recognized as a peer leader in their community.

The training will be led by experienced facilitators of the Ohio Peer Supporter integrated curriculum. Both trainings will last 3 days and will be held in central Ohio. These trainings will include didactic learning designed to enhance individual skills for guiding and engaging others, teach group facilitation, understand the roles and responsibilities of facilitators, and expand participants' understanding of mediating group process. Ultimately, participants will develop skills to ensure that the trainees understand their roles as Ohio Peer Supporters.
