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# **Addiction Treatment Pilot Program (ATPP) Overview for JLSCI**

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Implementation/SOTA**

# Program Summary

- Legislatively Established in Section 327.120 of the 2014/2015 State Budget.
- A Pilot program for treating adult offenders.
  - Provide addiction treatment to opiate and/or alcohol dependent persons.
  - Provide Medication Assisted Treatment
    - May use long-acting antagonist or partial agonist medications.
    - Must be FDA approved for treating alcohol and/or opioid dependence.
  - Provide other types of therapies for co-occurring disorders.



# Program Summary

- ATPP must be evaluated.
- OhioMHAS issued RFP on August 1, 2013.
- Begun Center at Case Western Reserve University Selected.
- No later than six months from the conclusion (June 30, 2015) of the ATPP, Case Western shall deliver a report on its findings to:
  - The Governor.
  - The Chief justice of the Supreme Court.
  - The President of the Senate.
  - The Speaker of the House of Representatives.
  - OhioMHAS.
  - The Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.



# Program Eligibility

- Person is actively engaged with a drug court certified by the Supreme Court of Ohio located in one of the following counties:
  - Crawford
  - Franklin
  - Hardin
  - Mercer
  - Scioto



# Treatment Responsibilities

- Treatment provided by a community addiction services provider certified by OhioMHAS.
- Addiction services provider responsibilities:
  - Provide treatment using an integrated service delivery model.
  - Conduct comprehensive assessments.
  - Recommend treatment services.
  - Develop individualized goals and objectives.
  - Provide access to medications.
  - Provide other therapies as necessary.
  - Monitor compliance – i.e. urinalysis.



# Budget and Financing

- Appropriated \$5,000,000.
- \$200,000 utilized for the required evaluation study.
- \$50,000 utilized for supporting this two day training.
- \$4,750,000 remaining for treatment and medications.
- Will be paying community addiction services providers \$2,000 per monthly member slot.
- Payment covers treatment and medication.
