Access to Recovery (ATR) IV is a three-year competitive \$7,084,767 grant program, awarded to the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services by the federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration.

It provides electronic vouchers to criminal-justice-involved adults and military service members for the purchase of recovery support and treatment services from a potential cohort of 70 providers, currently in Cuyahoga, Franklin, Hamilton, Lorain, Montgomery, Stark and Summit Counties.
