<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two measures for treatment services: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Retention • Disposition at discharge • Retention has three indicators: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Washington Circle</i> (At least one clinical encounter within the first 14 days post-assessment, and two additional encounters within the 30-day period) • <i>NIATx</i> (At least four clinical encounters within the first 30 days post-assessment) • <i>ODADAS</i> (60 or more days of services per episode of care) • The 18 dispositions at discharge were grouped into five categories: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assessment only • Negative • Neutral • Positive • Referral <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ratio of positive to negative dispositions will also be measured • Four levels of measurement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provider • Board • Region (<i>Metropolitan, Suburban, Appalachian, Non-Appalachian, Rural</i>) • State 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subgroups: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drug of choice • Length of stay • Level of care • Population group • Clients referred to other substance abuse treatment and/or mental health services • Population groups: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Age <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adolescents (12-17 years) • Young adults (18-25 years) • Adults (18 years and older) • Older adults (60 years and older) • Criminal justice involved • Deaf or hard of hearing • Dually diagnosed • Gender • Mental health history • Methamphetamine-using client • Opiate-using client • Poly-substance user • Service member or veteran 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two groups of outcomes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recovery support measures • Post-discharge measures • Two targeted recovery support measures: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employment/Enrolled in school • Housing • Recovery support <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Represented by the difference between client status at admission and client status at discharge • Post-discharge measures: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Abstinence • Criminal justice involvement • Employment/Enrolled in school • Housing • Social connectedness • Two post-discharge measurement points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Six-month • One-year
