I. Old Business:

- a. **Minutes** from April 1, 2016 Approved
- b. **MAT Survey:** Since last meeting J. Ellis drafted a MAT survey designed to illuminate disparities in the field regarding adoption of MATs. B. Lander formatted the instrument into SurveyMonkey. Membership edited the document and discussed process and timelines:
 - i. Draft Survey Cover letter (J. Ellis)
 - ii. Final Survey Formatting (B. Lander)
 - iii. Survey and Cover forward to L. Criss
 - iv. Ohio Council to forward survey to all AoD Membership, and all recovery Housing providers.
 - v. Data received and aggregated (B. Lander)
 - vi. Discuss responses at June Meeting- Develop recommendations
 - vii. Invite Key Stakeholders to July Meeting to address Results/recommendations
 - viii. Formal recommendations to OhioMHAS/Field
- c. **Membership:** Group agreed to send correspondence to old Roundtable members who have either completed their terms, or are no longer an active member of the group. Letter will thank them for service. Roundtable will recruit for new members, while ensuring coverage from metropolitan, suburban, and rural areas.
- d. **Confidentiality Law:** J. Starr will follow-up to determine OhioMHAS stance on retaining services from the Legal Action Center regarding 42CFR and HIPAA.

II. Rules Review:

- a. Following are comments/recommendations/questions regarding rules reviewed:
 - i. **Rule 29-13 (C):** States a residential treatment provider may admit individuals “who do not necessarily need the level of care specified.” The group has some concern with this item given the scarcity of the resource. The rule should at least add “if a more suitable level of care is not available.
 - ii. **Rule 29-14:** Replace the term “narcotic” with “opioid.”
 - iii. **Rule 29-30:** H. Henry introduced newly drafted rule regarding eligible providers and supervisors. The group suggests adding how the competencies would be quantified/demonstrated in section (C)-2.
 - iv. Forward group recommendations to H. Henry via April/May meeting minutes.

- a. Group discussed new potent opiate being abused in Ohio: U-4770. This may be classified as Schedule 1.
