## >>> More than \$6.8 Million Awarded To Businesses, Nonprofits and Valuesbased Groups to Mentor Students through Ohio's New Community Connectors Program

Eighty-two community partnerships will share more than \$6.8 million as part of Ohio's new Community Connectors school mentorship program. In all, the state received 192 applications for funding and each application included a business, civic and values-based partner organization. Ohio Gov. John R. Kasich proposed the creation of the Community Connectors program in his 2014 State of the State address to help give more Ohio students access to role models who can help motivate and inspire them, as well as help them develop skills that lead to success in school and the workplace.
