## **Vision:**


*To advance Trauma Informed practice (TI) as a cornerstone of Ohio's healthcare system*

## **Mission:**



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# Framework for Ohio's Trauma Informed (TI) Care

- **Statewide Advisory Group:** State/regional partners and sponsors support of statewide implementation of TI practice.
- **Interdepartmental Team:** State department leadership and identified experts assist with coordinating, facilitating and communicating about TI; responsible for the Internal Departmental Implementation of TI and the Statewide TI Propagation and Sustainability Plan. The team assists in developing the project timeline, the budget, the identified outcomes and the communication plan, and advises the department leadership and statewide advisory group and monitors statewide implementation.
- **Trauma Program Manager:** Works with the Technical Support Organizations (TSOs) and develops working relationships with stakeholders and partners. Project manager oversees the day to day coordination and collaboration of the training and implementation of TI throughout the state; provides regular reports and updates to all of the above.

# Framework for Ohio's Trauma Informed (TI) Care

- **Technical Support Organizations (TSOs):** Organizations that assist in the transmission of TIC throughout Ohio, in consultation and collaboration with the National Center for Trauma Informed Care (NCTIC), the Statewide Advisory Group, and the Interdepartmental Leadership Team.
- **Statewide TI Propagation and Sustainability Plan for MH, DD and AoD:** Created by the Governance and Leadership teams, supported by the TSOs. The TSO assists the regional teams, connecting experts and champions, assisting with training, sharing of resources and problem solving. Availability of a repository of expertise, knowledge, gaps, shared resources and assist in dissemination of information. Support the implementation of TI throughout state, assuring that TI opportunities are available everywhere.

# Framework for Ohio's Trauma Informed (TI) Care

- **Develop Outline for TI Training/Summit with NCTIC**
  - Thematic statewide training for Clinical and Administrative leaders; Regional breakouts
  - Develop regional groups to advance TIC within regions, to encompass all 88 counties
- **Develop Regional TI workgroups/teams**
  - Identification of strengths, weaknesses, needs, champions and areas of excellence to be used as resources in TIC implementation.
  - Community agencies/partners trained as trainers, resources identified and shared
  - Topical groups developed as indicated: Child, Older Adult, AoD, etc.
- **Interdepartmental Regional Activity/Implementation:**
  - Targeted TI training; connection with Regional TI workgroups/teams; community agencies and specialty groups
- **Ongoing Communication and Training for Regions, Boards, Agencies and Providers**
