

MACSIS PROCEDURE CODE TABLES
For Mental Health (MH) and Alcohol and Drug (AOD)

A brief description of the columns contained on these documents is noted below:

Column	Contains
Service Code description	This column contains the service name as currently reflected in the certification standards.
Former MACSIS Code	This column contains the MACSIS procedure service code that has been historically used to capture certified services.
Certification Reference	This column contains the Ohio Administrative code certification reference that defines each service.
Health care or non-Health	This column contains the Healthcare services versus non-healthcare services are broadly grouped as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HealthCare applies to those services where CMS assigned a healthcare code and/or description that generally aligns with our definition and non-healthcare applies when a code or its description does not align with a code that assigned by CMS.
Code Description	This column contains the service name as nationally-defined for healthcare services and as assigned by ODMH or ODADAS for non healthcare services.
Type of Code	This column identifies the type of service code (ex. HCPCS, CPT-4 or MACSIS).
Proposed Time Increment	If blank, one base unit of service equates to 60 minutes. Please note that the national HCPCS service definition dictates the base unit of service for many of the 15-minute services noted.
Modifier 1	ODADAS Procedure code table defines the values that will be accepted in Modifier 1 for each service
Modifier 2	ODADAS Procedure code table defines the values that will be accepted in Modifier 2 for each service
Modifier 3	ODADAS Procedure code table defines the values that will be accepted in Modifier 3 for each service
Modifier 4	ODADAS Procedure code table defines the values that will be accepted in Modifier 4 for each service
