

**OHIO DEPARTMENT OF JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES
INTERAGENCY SUBGRANT/SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT
AMENDMENT 1**

This is Amendment 1 to the Interagency Subgrant/Subrecipient Agreement between the State of Ohio, Department of Job and Family Services (hereinafter referred to as "ODJFS") and Ohio Department of Mental Health (hereinafter referred to as "ODMH"), signed by ODJFS on July 25, 2011.

1. ARTICLE II, SECTION E Paragraph 3 is hereby amended to read:
 - a. Upon receipt of valid ISTVs from ODMH, ODJFS shall transfer up to Eighty-Nine Thousand, Eight Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$89,800.00) in SFY 2012 in Federal Funds for the ODMH MFP responsibilities outlined in ARTICLE III, Section F, Paragraph 3.
2. ARTICLE III, SECTION F, Paragraph 3, is hereby amended to read:
 - a. ODMH shall be reimbursed up to Thirty-Eight Thousand, Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$38,500.00) in MFP Federal funds for personnel costs for the MFP Liaison position for performing authorized activities as outlined in the MFP Operational Protocol.
3. ARTICLE III, SECTION F, Paragraph 3, is hereby amended to add the following Deliverables:
 - b. ODMH shall be reimbursed up to Fifty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$50,000.00) in MFP Federal funds for approved outreach and/or partnership development with emphasis on the development of appropriate accommodations for the more hard to serve MFP participants per the MFP Operational Protocol.
 - c. ODMH shall invoice ODJFS via an ISTV for the actual allowable reimbursed travel expenses, up to One Thousand, Three Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,300.00), in MFP Federal funds, for ODMH state staff travel for attendance at the 2011 Money Follows the Person Conference in Baltimore, MD. Documentation accompanying the ITSU shall include proof of the ODMH travel expenditure disbursement to the designated state staff.
4. ARTICLE V, SECTION A, is hereby amended to read:

The total amount of the federal award, including Money Follows the Person funding, is Three Hundred Ninety Million, Six Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand, Seventy-Six and 00/100 Dollars (\$390,665,076.00). ODJFS agrees to transfer up to Three Hundred Ninety Million, Six Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand, Seventy-Six and 00/100 Dollars (\$390,665,076.00) in Federal funds to ODMH in SFY 2012. Additionally, ODJFS shall transfer non-federal Disproportionate Share Hospital (DSH) payments referenced in ARTICLE II, Section E, Paragraph 2 to ODMH. The total transfer of DSH payments shall not exceed Three Million, Six Hundred Twenty-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$3,000,624.00) for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2012. It is expressly understood by ODJFS and ODMH that the terms of this Agreement do not allow total compensation in excess of Three Hundred Ninety-Three Million, Six Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand, Seven Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$393,665,700.00) for the period set forth in ARTICLE IV.

All obligations under this Agreement are subject to the requirements of ORC 126.07.

5. All other terms of the Agreement are hereby affirmed.
