



ODMH Health Homes Technical Assistance and Training Initiatives Strategy

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

Select Evidence-Based Practices Training for Health Homes*

The primary goal of this initiative is to support the implementation of CBHC Health Homes and train health home teams on select evidence-based practices to enhance the provision of the health home service to individuals with SPMI.

Key health home team core competencies and skills will include:

- Motivational Interviewing
- Approaches to Behavior Change
- Stages of Change
- Tobacco Cessation

- Develop and distribute printed and electronic materials to NAMI affiliates and stakeholders statewide
- Engage Health Home service providers to share site specific lessons learned
- In collaboration with OEC, deliver face-to-face presentations on Health Home service benefits




