Title: Ex-Offender Reentry Mini Grant Recipients

The Ohio Department of Mental Health (ODMH) received eighteen (18) Ex-Offender Reentry Mini grant applications for consideration. We are pleased to announce that of those 18, ODMH was able to fund fourteen (14) grants for a total of \$400,000. It is estimated that over 350 offenders with serious and persistent mental illness will be served by these dollars. In choosing to fund projects, the evaluators took into consideration the following: 1) the target population; 2) the ability to increase capacity to serve the population or increase the services to the population if already being served; 3) the total number of potential offenders that will be served; 4) amount requested; and 5) the overall quality of the project being proposed.
