RE: Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2012 Federal Medical Assistance Percentage
(FMAP) and enhanced FMAP Change Notification

ODMH Numbered Advisory: 8-FY12-2

Per the attached Federal Register notification published on November 10, 2010, effective **October 1, 2011** the revised FMAP for the ODADAS and ODMH Community Medicaid programs is 64.15%. The revised enhanced FMAP for the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) and persons eligible for Medicaid under the Breast and Cervical Cancer (BCC) category is 74.91%. These changes will be reflected in all Medicaid Federal Financial Participation (FFP) reimbursements processed by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) on or after October 1, 2011 regardless of the date of service.

The corresponding federal awards for the State of Ohio for this time period are: Medicaid Cluster Award (Subsidy), Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) 93.778, Award number 1205OH5028 and SCHIP CFDA 93.767, Award number 1205OH5021. All cover the period of October 1, 2011 to September 30, 2012 and are awarded by the United States Department of Health and Human Services.

For Medicaid claims with dates of service prior to July 1, 2011, Boards should be tracking all federal reimbursement by CFDA number for audit purposes and federal reporting. To assist with this, the amount by each program is identified on ODADAS and ODMH Medicaid voucher reports as well as at the claim detail level.
