RE: Outcomes Missing Data Report 4

We are pleased to be able to send you the Ohio Mental Health Consumer Outcomes System Missing Data Report 4. This report covers the time period from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004.

The report compares the number of individuals who had Outcomes ratings in the statewide database to the number of individuals who received services that made the eligible to have their Outcomes reported. The report has a listing for each board area as a whole as well as for each agency within the board area, and information for adults and children/adolescents is listed separately.

This report should be used as a quality improvement tool for local systems about how they are doing with regard to the submission of Outcomes data to ODMH. We are aware from production reports that data submissions have increased significantly in the past couple of months, hence some data are not reflected in this report. However, boards should focus attention on agencies that have no or low data submission percentages in the report, since their Certification may soon be in jeopardy. The Consumer Outcomes Rule requires that agencies collect data on all their clients and that they flow these data to ODMH by September 4, 2004. The most recent information about agencies' data submission status can be found on the Outcomes Web site at www.mh.state.oh.us/initiatives/outcomes/outcomes.html.

We would greatly appreciate it if boards e-mailed this report to all of their provider agencies or distributed it in hard copy to agencies that do not have electronic mail. Agencies need to know that we will be using this report in the process of considering Certification applications as well as for our own monitoring of local systems. To date, a number of agencies have had their Certification held until a plan of correction was filed to bring the agency into compliance with the Consumer Outcomes Rule.

Individuals with Outcomes Ratings in the Statewide Database Compared to Individuals with Eligible Claims
July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004

The following table compares the number of individuals with Outcomes ratings in the statewide database to the number of individuals with eligible claims for FY04 (i.e., July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004). Each column in the table is described below.

Board--an alphabetical listing of the 50 board areas in the state of Ohio.

Agency Name--an alphabetical listing of the agencies within each board area.

UPID--the unique provider identifier associated with each agency.

Adult Outcomes Received--the number of individuals with at least one Adult Consumer Form A, Adult Consumer Form B or Provider Form A rating in the statewide Outcomes database with an administration date during FY04 as of Oct 4, 2004. In order to be included in this column, individuals had to have at least one actual Outcomes item completed; individuals with only the "Tracking Sheet" variables completed were not included.

Adult Outcomes Expected--an approximation of the number of individuals from whom an Outcomes rating was expected assuming full local implementation of the Outcomes system. More specifically, the number of individuals who were at least 18 years of age and who had an eligible claim with a service date during FY04 as of Oct 4, 2004. Eligible claims were determined by the criteria set forth in "The Ohio Mental Health Consumer Outcomes System: Procedural Manual," page 3-9. For those individuals who received eligible services from more than one agency, the assignment for the major responsible service provider was determined by an algorithm with all types of eligible services. The procedure is detailed in the document "Procedures for Preparing Outcomes Expected (OE) and Outcomes Received (OR) for Missing Data Reports". In addition, individuals who had an Outcomes rating but did not have an eligible claim were added to the "Adult Outcomes Expected" column.

Adult OR/OE--the number of individuals in the "Adult Outcomes Received" column divided by the number of individuals in the "Adult Outcomes Expected" column.

Youth Outcomes Received--the number of individuals with at least one Ohio Scales Youth, Parent or Agency Worker rating in the statewide Outcomes database with an administration date during FY04 as of Oct 4, 2004. In order to be included in this column, individuals had to have at least one actual Outcomes item completed; individuals with only the "Tracking Sheet" variables completed were not included.

Youth Outcomes Expected--an approximation of the number of individuals from whom an Outcomes rating was expected assuming full local implementation of the Outcomes system. More specifically, the number of individuals who were at least 5 and less than 18 years of age and who had an eligible claim with a service date during FY04 as of Oct 4, 2004. Eligible claims were determined by the criteria set forth in "The Ohio Mental Health Consumer Outcomes System: Procedural Manual," page 3-9. For those individuals who received eligible services from more than one agency, the assignment for the major responsible service provider was determined by an algorithm with all types of eligible services. The procedure is detailed in the document "Procedures for Preparing Outcomes Expected (OE) and Outcomes Received (OR) for Missing Data Reports". In addition, individuals who had an Outcomes rating but did not have an eligible claim were added to the "Youth Outcomes Expected" column.

Youth OR/OE--the number of individuals in the "Youth Outcomes Received" column divided by the number of individuals in the "Youth Outcomes Expected" column.

Procedures for Preparing Outcomes Expected (OE) and Outcomes Received (OR) for Missing Data Reports

The following are the steps that OPER goes through in preparing each Missing Data Report:


1. Identify the time frame for the Missing Data Report: A one-year period is included in each Missing Data Report because at least one assessment is required within the time frame for each consumer. A three month period is allowed for update of MACSIS claims data and Outcomes data (i.e., data analysis will involve both claims data and Outcomes data between 15 months and three months earlier than the date of production data for the analysis. For example, data analysis for July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004 will employ production data aggregated for that time period by October 2004).
2. Request data files from MACSIS claims data and Outcomes Data.
3. Outcomes Expected (OE): Identify the major service provider for each consumer with one or more claims for Community Psychiatric Supportive Treatment¹ (CPST), Behavioral Health Counseling and Therapy² (BHCT), Partial Hospitalization (PH), Residential Care (RC), Pharmacologic Management³ (PM), Employment/Vocational (EV), Social & Recreational (SR), Occupational Therapy (OT), Adjunctive Therapy (AT). The major service provider for each consumer within the time frame of the report will be assigned according to the algorithm developed in the flow chart attached.
4. Outcomes Received (OR): Merge Outcomes production files for various instruments for adults and youth/kids respectively. For adult data, files from Adult Consumer A, Adult Provider A and Adult Consumer B will be merged. For youth/kids data, files from Ohio Scales Youth, Ohio Scales Parent, Ohio Scales Worker, and CAFAS will be merged. The merged data files will be examined and records with all Outcomes data missing will be excluded (i.e. records have to have at least one actual Outcomes item completed; records with only the "Tracking Sheet" variables completed will not be included).
5. Outcomes Received (OR): Identify the major service provider for Outcomes data received. For each unique consumer of Outcomes Expected data from (3) above:
 - If no Outcomes rating is received for a consumer, the Outcomes Received service provider is left blank.
 - If one or more Outcomes ratings are received and at least one Outcomes rating comes from the service provider corresponding to Outcomes Expected for that consumer, the service provider will be assigned as the Outcomes Received service provider.
 - If one or more Outcomes ratings are received and none of these Outcomes ratings comes from the service provider corresponding to Outcomes Expected for that consumer, the service provider from which the most recent Outcomes ratings were received will be assigned as both the Outcomes Expected service provider (replacing previous Outcomes Expected service provider in (3)) and Outcomes Received service provider.
6. For any record from Outcomes data without any match within MACSIS claims data, the service provider with the most recent Outcomes data will be assigned as the Outcomes Expected service provider and the record added to the list of Outcomes Expected. This service provider will also be assigned as the Outcomes Received service provider for that consumer.
7. Aggregated data files listing number of Outcomes Expected and Outcomes Received for each service provider will then be prepared for the Missing Data Report.
