The five measures highlighted in gray are provision and will be tested further for feasibility in the batch upload phase of OH BH-TEO records development.

There are 21 special populations on the list, most of which are pre-existing categories in the OH-BH. If the provider checks “SMD/SED” or any of the other three special pop categories in this short list, they can verify that the client meets criteria based on chronicity or treatment history. This option provides a way to over-ride the GAF threshold for SMD/SED and “register” the client as SMD/SED.
