- Is CAMS training one of the EBP that will be offered? CAMS is an EBP the department is looking to support and it will be offered by the Ohio Suicide Prevention Foundation through the SAMHSA Garret Lee Smith grant.
- Will these be open to our colleagues and friends that work in the mental health and/or recovery services departments within the Ohio Prison Systems? As we all know suicide is a real in the prison system as much as it is in the community. Initial round will be for community based health and behavioral health organizations providing clinical care.
- Is this training open to agencies working with youth? Yes
- Where if at all will schools be involved? Organizations interested in applying can identify team members outside of their organization, such as school personnel, if they believe that the individual is critical to the development and implementation of their Zero Suicide plan.
- If you are a part of a suicide prevention coalition - can part of the team consist of para professionals/survivors that are part of a LOSS Team? Organizations interested in applying are encouraged to include a team member with lived experience.
- How will this be coordinated with boards and local suicide prevention coalitions? Communication from OhioMHAS will go to boards, providers and other organizations through department publications.
- Any news on the amount of the stipend involved and how it is disbursed? Stipends will be in the amount of \$8,250.00 per organization.
- Could a suicide prevention coalition apply under the auspices of a Mental Health and Recovery Board, or must it be sponsored by a mental health treatment agency? Clinical care providers in behavioral health and primary care settings as well as Federally Qualified Health Centers are only eligible to apply.
- Beyond the training commitments, what is expected of the team/organization in regards to data collection? Identifying specific information on data collection will be part of the academies and learning collaborative.
- Can a freestanding inpatient psychiatric hospital apply for inclusion? Yes
