


Medication Assisted Treatment in Ohio

OARRS - Change in doses per 100 people from 2012 to 2013

Map Information:

This map represents county-level data on drugs commonly used in medication assisted treatment (MAT). It presents the change over time in MAT rates per 100 people for drugs including buprenorphine, Suboxone® and Subutex®. From 2012 to 2013 most counties experienced an increase in MAT rates per 100 people. Some of these increases seem dramatic, but they can be misleading because some of the MAT rates were very low in 2012. Geauga was the only county experiencing a decrease in MAT rates per 100 people.

Note: Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Boards have black borders, and counties have white borders. Borders are black in cases where ADAMHS boards and counties have the same borders.
