


Minutes to Hospital for Persons Administered Naloxone

Map Information:

This map represents the time it takes for EMTs to transport persons administered naloxone to the hospital in 2012. The total travel time adds together the time en route to the scene, the time at the scene and the travel time to the hospital. Counties with the longest total travel time to the hospital are Meigs (55.7), Scioto (52.1) and Hardin (51.0). Counties with the shortest total travel time to the hospital are Seneca (22.6), Clinton (23.0) and Tuscarawas (23.9).

Note: Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Boards have black borders, and counties have white borders. Borders are black in cases where ADAMHS boards and counties have the same borders.
