


Drug Possession Charges per 10,000 Persons

Ohio Incident-Based Reporting System - 2011

Map Information:

This map displays drug possession charges per 10,000 persons by county. In 2011 there were 26,649 charges for drug possession across the state. Summit (84.1), Montgomery (64.0) and Richland (56.6) counties had the highest rates of drug possession charges per 10,000 persons. Lucas (0.3), Allen (0.9) and Carroll (1.2) counties had the lowest rates of drug possession charges per 10,000 persons. Four counties reported no charges for drug possession, likely the result of not submitting possession data in 2011.

Note: Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Boards have black borders, and counties have white borders. Borders are black in cases where ADAMHS boards and counties have the same borders.
