Clusters of Unique Clients per 10,000 Persons - State Fiscal Year 2010

Map Information:

This map uses hot spot analysis to display clusters of unique clients in treatment per 10,000 persons who list either heroin or prescription opioids as a primary drug of choice. Hot spots are indicated by three different colors and show spatial clusters that are statistically significant. In SFY 2010 some counties are only significant for prescription opioids, while others are only significant for heroin. Hot spots colored dark red are significant for both opiates.

Note: Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Boards have black borders, and counties have white borders. Borders are black in cases where ADAMHS boards and counties have the same borders.
