


Property Crime Charges per 10,000 Persons

Ohio Incident-Based Reporting System - 2012

Map Information:

This map displays property crime charges per 10,000 persons by county. In 2012 there were 282,060 charges for property crimes across the state, averaging 244.3 per 10,000 persons. Ross (516.1), Marion (506.7) and Fayette (483.0) counties had the highest property crime rates per 10,000 persons. Sandusky (0.8), Lake (10.5) and Allen (30.1) counties had the lowest property crime rates per 10,000 persons. One county reported no charges for property crime, likely the result of not submitting data.

Note: Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Boards have black borders, and counties have white borders. Borders are black in cases where ADAMHS boards and counties have the same borders.
