Program:

Thank you all for your assistance in submitting the quarterly report questions. We apologize for the short notice and turn-around, but we submitted to SAMHSA by the revised deadline. Deb will develop a form consisting of the questions SAMHSA is requesting on quarterly bases to be reported on. That form along with the budget

State Plan (CABHI Infrastructure) has been completed, reviewed and approved for submission by the Housing and Homelessness Collaborative (HHC); therefore, we are awaiting feedback and/or approval from SAMHS.

A question was asked for clarity of how people are flowing into/through the process and a response was shared; therefore, a draft the flow will be developed and shared for input/feedback to help ensure we are all following the same processes.

The CABHI Disparity Impact Statement (DIS) has been prepared and submitted [we are anticipating that this information will now be a requirement]. This information will be tracked and monitored annually.

National Culturally and Linguistically Appropriate Service (CLAS) Standards: heads up, there will be additional information coming soon. The CABHI (and PATH) Grant(s) required reporting per the Federal RFA include meeting these standards.

CTI Training(s) by FrontLine Service:

- Cuyahoga – Has been completed (inter-agency training)
- Franklin County's two-day training will be held at the Southeast, Inc. on February 18 and 19th
- Hamilton County's two-day training was held at the Hamilton County Mental Health Board on February 3rd and 4th
- Montgomery – has been scheduled to be held March 3rd and 4th
- Summit – In process of scheduling
