- PNC Bank Representative spoke about various PNC bank products that could be useful to PATH consumers that have income. Answered questions.

SOAR Trainings

- Raven Oglesby, COHHIO, explained that she would be offering a SSI/SSDI Outreach, Access, and Recovery (SOAR) training later this fall for PATH staff. Also shared she would be offering a more intensive training for new CABHI program staff and PATH staff could attend that as well. Answered questions. Discussed SAMHSA support of SOAR.

Updates: Program, Community, Housing and Homelessness Conference; PDX Quarterly/Annual Reports; Award (NOSA)

- Deb reviewed information from the NAEH conference.
- Roma announced that the Cooperative Agreement to Benefit Homeless Individuals (CABHI) Enhancement grant was approved. Roma explained that SAMHSA is interested in knowing what technical assistance needs there are for the project. Roma shared that this is an infrastructure grant.
- Roma shared the Recovery Housing Access to Recovery grant was approved.
- Additionally Roma discussed that OhioMHAS will be taking over the mental health treatment in the prisons so that there is continuity of care when they are discharged from the prison into the mental health system.
- Deb shared movie previews for "Time out of Mind" and "The Anonymous People".
- Deb asked that providers share some successes in their communities.

Discussed concerns and issues. • Deb and Jonda discussed concerns with providers using different categories of services for the same tasks that are being completed. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Decision made that all providers will do homework and come prepared to next meeting with a list of tasks that they do under the various categories. ○ Everyone is also to review the Guidance document before the next meeting so they are familiar with the definitions that PATH has provided.
