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OhioMHAS RH Federal Support

- Cooperative Agreement to Benefit Homelessness (CABHI)
 - \$3.6 million (2014-2017)/ \$3.6 million Enhancement (2015-17)
 - Provides outreach services to individuals with SUD that meet the definition of Chronic Homelessness
 - Supports Recovery Housing as a permanent housing option
 - CABHI areas (Cuyahoga, Franklin, Hamilton, Montgomery, Summit, Lucas, Mahoning/Trumbull, Stark)
- Access to Recovery (ATR)
 - \$7,000,000 3 year Federal Grant (5/2015 – 4/30/2018)
 - Provides direct funding for RH and other recovery supports in seven targeted areas (Cuyahoga, Summit, Stark, Lorain, Franklin, Hamilton, Montgomery)
 - Technical Assistance leveraging opportunity (Star Behavioral Health, Housing Strategic Planning, CCAR Recovery Coaching, Integrated Peer Supporter Curriculum, Zeal to Skill, Mental Health First Aid)



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OhioMHAS RH State Support

- Recovery Housing State General Revenue Fund (GRF)
 - State budgeted funding allocated in a two year cycle for RH operations support and for support to ORH (ex. SFY 16/17)
 - Typically accessed via Request for Proposal
- Recovery Housing Capital Bond Dollars
 - State bond dollar investments allocated in an alternate two year cycle for brick and mortar projects (ex. SFY 15/16)
 - Board support required
- Recovery Housing Resource Hub and Learning Community
 - Supported through several partnerships
