Bridges Out of Poverty workshop provides both the social service provider and the community member key lessons in dealing with individuals from poverty. Topics include increasing awareness of the differences in economic cultures and how those differences affect opportunities for success. This workshop is based on the book *Bridges Out of Poverty: Strategies for Professionals and Communities*, a collaboration between Ruby K. Payne, Phillip DeVol, and Terie Dreussi Smith.

The trainer, Kathy McPherson of Columbus, Ohio, has been working in the field of chemical dependency since 1993. As a certified chemical dependency and intervention counselor/case manager, she has worked with adult men, women, and children, the majority of whom were indigent. She held dual roles as a counselor and court liaison, collaborating with the Franklin County mental health court, family drug court, and TIES felony drug court programs.

Learning Objectives:

- Develop an accurate mental model of generational poverty and explore the impact of poverty on those served by the organization.
- Review research on the causes of poverty.
- Explore the hidden rules of economic class.
- Examine the impact of poverty on family structures.
- Explore registers of language, discourse patterns, and cognitive issues.
- Define poverty in terms of the resources needed for a stable life.
- Identify ways in which the information can be used to improve relationships and outcomes: individual, organizational, and community.
