1. What services can be provided with CCBH funds?

CCBH funds can be used to provide clinical intervention and treatment for children and youth ages 0-17, clinical programs that address gaps in treatment services, Medicaid match, and as match for any other federally funded clinical treatment programs. 2. Can CCBH funds be used for assessments?

Yes, CCBH funds can be used for any type of clinical assessment, including assessments of social / emotional competence.

3. Who can provide treatment services with CCBH funds?

Treatment services provided with these funds must be provided by organizations that are certified by ODMH to provide mental health services (see, i.e. -Ohio Administrative Code Rule 5122-25-01) or by ODADAS to provide alcohol and drug addiction services (see, i.e. -Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3793:2-1-01).

4. Can CCBH funds be used for therapeutic or treatment foster care?

Yes, the CCBH Guidance Document definition of "Out-of-home treatment overnight" includes therapeutic or treatment foster care as an authorized use of CCBH funds. See CCBH Guidance Document definitions on page 7.
