# Critical Teaming Outcomes


- Understanding expectations of the Court



# Risk Management

Risk Management is the identification, assessment, and prioritization of risks followed by the coordinated application of resources to minimize, monitor, and control the probability and/or impact of unfortunate events.



# Indicators of Risk-Behavioral Healthcare

- Chronic, long term mental illness.
- Untreated mental illness.
- Non-compliance with treatment.
- Physical healthcare issues.
- Violent & aggressive behaviors.
- Housing issues & homelessness.
- Extreme poverty & hunger.
- Lack of or loss of natural support system.
- Multiple hospitalizations or institutionalization.
- At risk of out of home placement.
- Involvement with criminal justice system.
- Involvement with multiple systems of care.
- Lack of access to resources.
- Exposure to trauma, abuse, and/or neglect.
- Substance abuse/dependency

# Indicators of Risk-Developmental Disabilities

- **Disrupted living situation.**
- **Medical problems.**
- **Mental Health/substance abuse problems.**
- **Involvement with criminal justice system.**
- **Lack of access to necessary services.**
- **Lack of basic necessities.**
- **Exposure to trauma, abuse, and/or neglect.**
- **Housing issues & homelessness.**
- **Extreme poverty & hunger.**
- **Lack of or loss of natural support system.**
- **Social isolation.**

# **Additional Indicators of Risk for the Dually Diagnosed**

- **Indicators of risk for behavioral healthcare.**
- **Indicators of risk for developmental disabilities.**

**PLUS**

- **Chronic, highly disruptive community behavior.**
- **‘Burned bridges’ with providers in different systems of care.**
- **Failed care and treatment planning.**
- **Non-compliance with care and treatment recommendations.**
- **Continual movement from one restricted setting to another. (i.e. jail to hospital to developmental center).**
- **No one system of care can meet needs or lacks resources to meet needs.**
- **Frustrated professionals.**

- **Criminal History**
- **Education, Employment and Financial Situation**
- **Family and Social Support**
- **Peer Associations**
- **Neighborhood Problems**
- **Substance Use**
- **Criminal Attitudes and Behavioral Patterns**



# Conditional Release Planning

- Identify, characterize, and assess threats
- Determine risk
- Static vs. Dynamic Risk Factors
- Protective Factors: Conditions or interventions needed to manage or reduce those threats.
