Welcome

Dawn welcomed the committee members to the conference call and took attendance. Dawn informed the committee that there were some minor changes made to the minutes to accurately reflect attendance. The committee was asked to review the meeting minutes from the December 18, 2013 conference call meeting. Marcie Seidel made a motion for the minutes to be approved as written and Judi Moseley seconded the motion. The minutes from 12/18/13 meeting were accepted as written.

SAMHSA Updates

Dawn informed the committee that she was working with SAMHSA CSAP on getting more information about a no-cost extension. After Dawn's brief discussion with Kameisha Bennett (SAMHSA CSAP) Ohio's SPF SIG Project Officer at the CADCA Conference earlier in the month it was decided that Ohio would apply for a no-cost extension. Dawn would be contacting Kameisha at a later date to follow up with all the details.

Training Updates

Tracee Garrett gave an update on training. Global Insight is aggressively working on moving information from the old SPF SIG website to the new site housed under OhioMHAS. As they continue working on the new website they want to make sure that the site is easier to navigate and locate information. The goal is to have the website completed by the end of the first quarter. The Winter Webinar/Sustainability training from January 22, 2014 is currently on the SPF SIG website.

Global is currently collecting success stories from SPF SIG grantees and they are working to put those on the website.

Global is still providing training as communities are trying to schedule last minute training before the end of the grant. Franklin County has scheduled some training for their coalition. Global Insight will pay for any SPF SIG grantees that are interested in attending the A Better World Forum – Diversity and Inclusion Efforts. The training will be held on February 26th from 7:30a.m. – 10:30a.m. An email was sent out to all SPF SIG grantees announcing the training and details.

OSAM and SEOW Updates

SPF SIG Sub-Recipient Update

Dr. Holly Raffle provided an update on the status of Ohio's SPF SIG sub-recipient communities. All 13 SPF SIG communities now have approved Needs Assessments. There are currently 12/13 approved community logic models (exception of Mahoning). There are 11/13 strategic plans approved (Lorain & Mahoning pending). Detailed information on the status of Ohio's sub-recipient communities can be found in the OSET Update 2/12/14 (see attached).

The next sustainability call will be held on 2/19/14 and Dr. Judy Millisen will present on "Diversifying Your Portfolio". On the March sustainability call (3/19/14) the SPF SIG communities will be providing updates on their progress thus far with sustainability plans.

SPF SIG EBP Workgroup

Dr. Holly Raffle provided an update on the SPF EBP Workgroup. Almost all of the SPF SIG community reviews are complete and the rest will be done via email and/or individual team meetings. The SPF EBP Workgroup has reviewed the Ohio Youth Led Prevention Network Toolkit and provided feedback for revisions etc. This group will also participate in reviews of the Safe Schools Healthy Initiative grantee

projects as needed. The SPF SIG EBP Workgroup will continue to sustain after the SPF SIG project has ended.

Alcohol Edu

The IHEs have been doing amazing work. They have taken over ownership of the sustainability group and most of the schools are on their way to having some type of individual level programs on campus. They have done a lot of research on other programs and realize there are a variety of options that exist for their selection. Jennifer Smolowitz an intern with Ohio University has been very instrumental in assisting this group by providing notes, following up with potential vendors and coordinating the monthly sustainability conference calls. The next call will be held on 3/10/14 and their sustainability plans will be due April 15, 2014.

Additional Committee Updates

Judi Moseley announced that the Ohio Department of Health has funded 3 new DAWN projects in Hamilton County, Ross County and Stark County working with high-risk populations. HB-170 is currently being considered in committee. Ken Hale will be presenting at the Ohio State University's Collegiate Conference on August 5th – 7th. The first day will focus on prescription drug abuse and the second day will focus on alcohol.

Marcie Seidel announced that Drug Free Action Alliance is working with 8 other states to sponsor the Midwest Alcohol Policy Summit. They will have a number of nationally recognized speakers including Ann Dowsett Johnson, the author of the book Drink. Ann Johnson is an expert on alcohol and women. There will be a book signing April 1st at Barnes & Noble followed by a reception. Marcie also announced that the Ohio Youth Led Prevention Rally will take place on April 30, 2014 downtown at the Columbus Commons and the Statehouse. She also mentioned there will be a Community Forum on Marijuana February 19, 2014 with Dr. Peter Rogers at the Columbus Museum of Art. The topic is the legalization of marijuana.

Dawn also announced that Ohio MHAS Office of Prevention & Wellness in conjunction with Ohio Department of Health will present a combined OPEC Conference with Early Childhood to be held June 2nd – June 5th at Ohio Wesleyan University. Details to follow.
