Target Population: 18-25 year old young adults in Sandusky County

Problem Statement		
Of the Sandusky County 18-25 year olds who consumed alcohol in the past 30 days, almost half reported having 5 or more drinks per occasion during the same time period (Echo Survey 2012).

<p>Alcohol Use Indicators</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 39% of 18-25 year olds in Sandusky County reported drinking an alcoholic beverage within the past 30 days (ECHO Survey 2012). • Of Sandusky County 18-25 year-olds who consumed alcohol in the past 30-days, 47% report having had 5 or more drinks per occasion during the same time period (ECHO Survey 2012). • 12% of 18-25 year olds in Sandusky County who consumed alcohol within their lifetime reported drinking at least once a week (ECHO Survey 2012). • 89% of 18-25 year olds in Sandusky County that have consumed alcohol within their lifetime report being drunk at a party (ECHO Survey 2012). 	<p>There is no information regarding American Medical Association responsible drinking guidelines currently being disseminated in Sandusky County.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alcohol-related education in Sandusky County focuses on abstinence (Sandusky County Prevention Partnership, Organizational Assessment). • Alcohol-related education in Sandusky County focuses on individuals under the age of 18 (Sandusky County Prevention Partnership, Organizational Assessment). 	<p>There is a high level of social availability of alcohol among young adults between the ages of 18-25 in Sandusky County.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 64% of 18-25 year-olds in Sandusky County report that they know of parents or adults who permit non-family members under age 21 to consume alcohol in their home (ECHO Survey 2012). • 79% of 18-25 year-olds in Sandusky County last drank alcohol at their home or a friend's home (ECHO Survey 2012). • 22% of 18-25 year olds in Sandusky County obtain alcohol from older friends and family (ECHO Survey 2012). • 42% of 18-25 year olds in Sandusky County have obtained alcohol by going to a gathering with a small group of friends (ECHO Survey 2012).
