Participants' use of illicit drugs decreased from 85% to 12%



No or shorter stays in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit



71% remained in the program / 31% started treatment in their 1st trimester

PROJECT SUCCESSES

MOMS is a program for pregnant women and moms that struggle with opioid use. A whole care team of doctors and other staff work with women to understand their needs and support them. Results indicate positive outcomes for many of the women and their infants. These outcomes include infants with healthy birth weights, no or shorter stays in the neonatal intensive care units (NICU), fewer infants born with Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS), fewer infants with feeding and respiratory issues and many mothers in recovery at the time of birth.
