

State Opioid Response Funding Guidelines



REQUIRED ACTIVITIES

- Provide evidence-based prevention, treatment & recovery supports
- Include MAT with detox services
- Train peers and first responders to use naloxone
- Collect direct client service data through GPRA
- Collect demographic data on anonymous services
- Ensure eligible practitioners receive DATA waiver



ALLOWABLE EXPENSES

SOR 2.0 only

- Services specifically addressing stimulant or opioid misuse issues, in conjunction with other co-occurring disorders
- Contingencies no more than \$15 to rewarding treatment compliance totaling \$75 or less per client per year in treatment

SOR NCE only

- Services for individuals with a diagnosis of an opioid use disorder or demonstrated history of opioid overdose problems



UNALLOWABLE EXPENSES

- Services that can be supported through other sources of funding
- Direct payments to clients to enter or continue services
- Positions exceeding \$192,300 annually
- Denial of services for using FDA-approved medications for SUD
- DATA Waiver Training or incentives for obtaining DATA Waiver
- Purchase, prescribe, or provide treatment using marijuana
- Lease beyond the project period
- Capital or construction expenses
- Food, travel, conference or training expenses
