



Ohio Pre-Admission Screen and Resident Review (PASRR)

Annual Performance

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Section I: Executive Summary

The data in this report are compiled based on all Preadmission Screening (PAS) and Resident Reviews (RR) completed for the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services PASRR Bureau. In 2018, KEPRO and MHAS processed 5,978 Preadmission and 6,975 Resident Review applications, for a total of 12,953 cases.

KEPRO's contracted turnaround time (TAT) for expedited assessments originating from psychiatric units is 24 hours from receipt of application. For 2018, KEPRO completed 3,899 expedited assessments for individuals diagnosed with serious mental illness (SMI), of which 118 were for individuals with dual diagnosis (SMI & Intellectual Disability/Related Condition). KEPRO's average TAT for expedited assessments was 24.1 hours. The overall TAT for all expedited reviews from receipt of the application to issuing notification of results was 37.6¹ hours during the year.

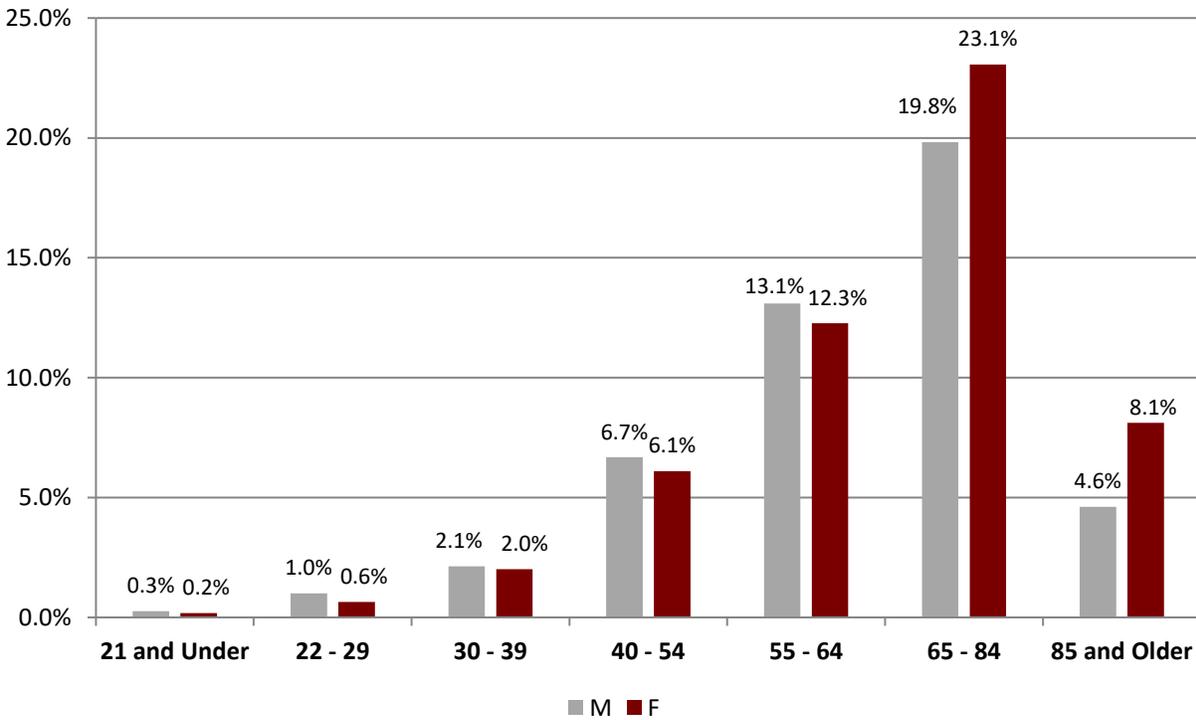
KEPRO's contracted turnaround time (TAT) for all non-expedited PAS and RR assessments is 3-5 calendar days. KEPRO's total average TAT for non-expedited assessments for 2018 was 1.3 calendar days, which met the contract deliverable. The federal standard for completion of PASRR assessments is 7-9 business days, which Ohio MHAS exceeded by completing all assessments in 1.3 business days on average.

Figure IIIa – 2018 Pre-Admission Outcome Percentages

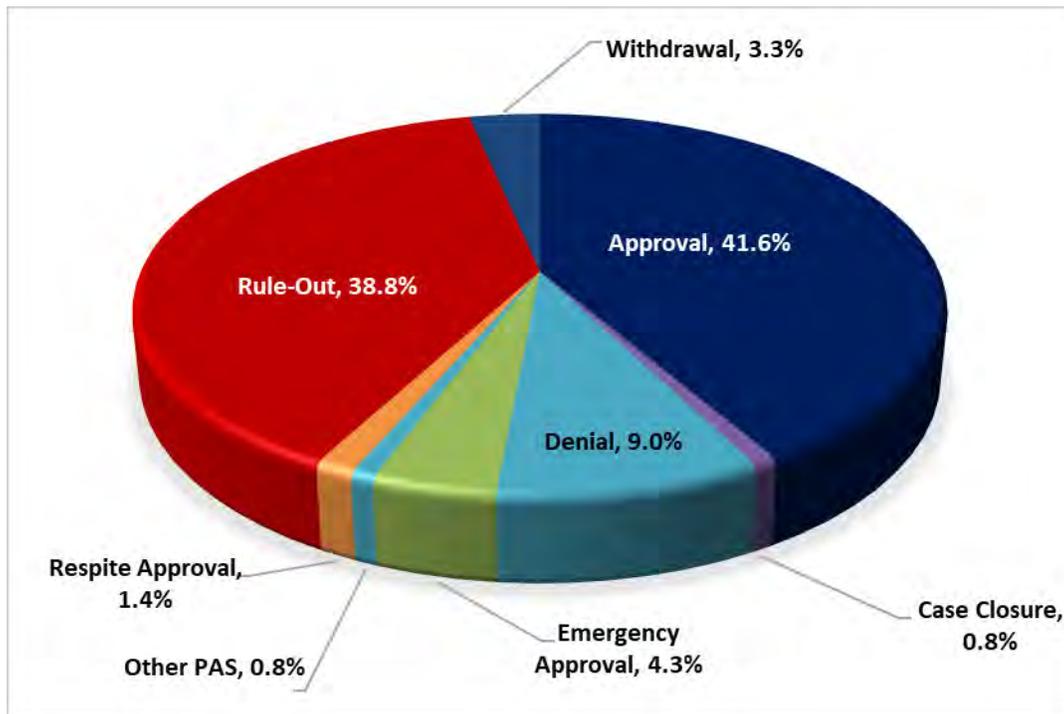

Figure IIIb – 2018 Resident Review Outcome Percentages

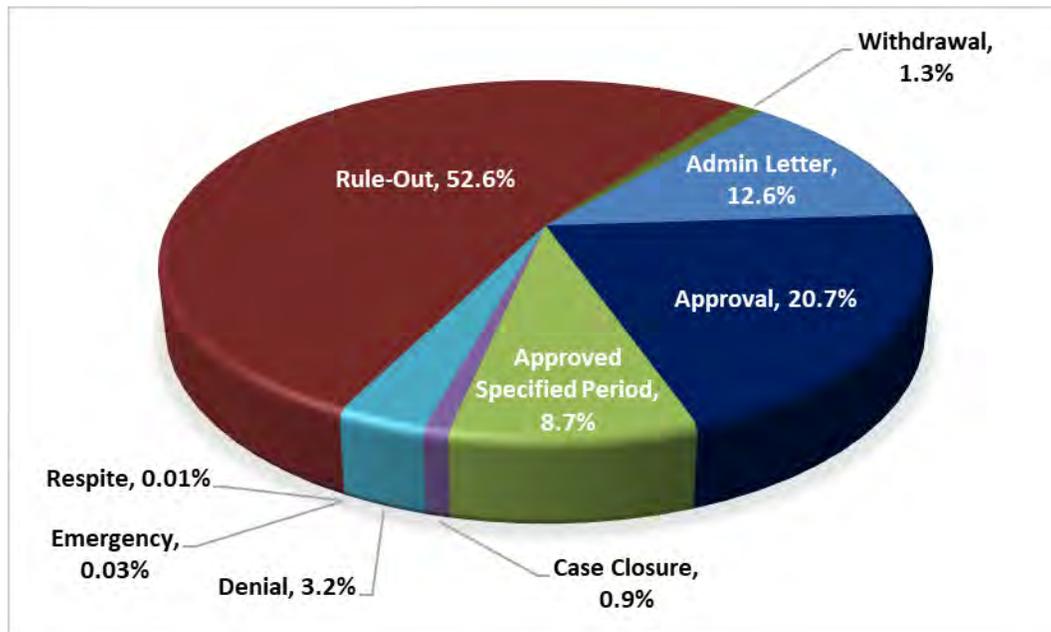
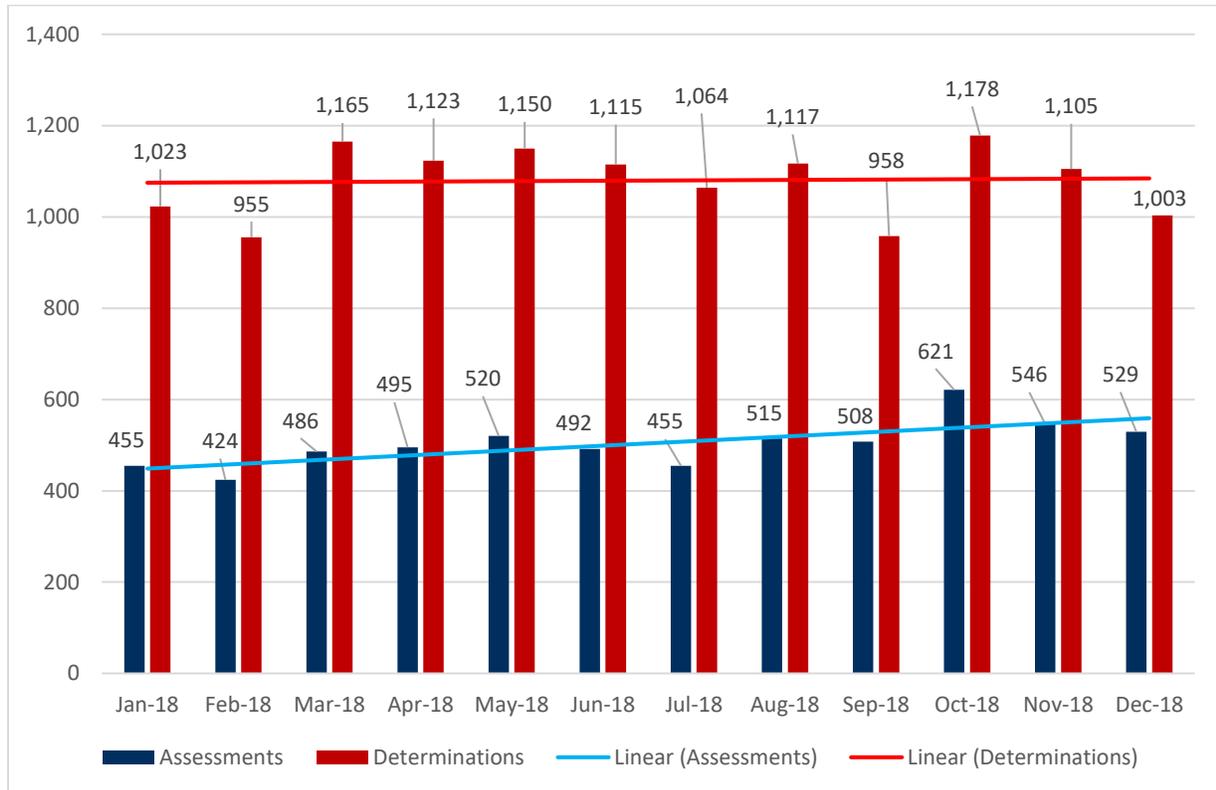


Figure IIIc – Determinations vs. Assessed Cases

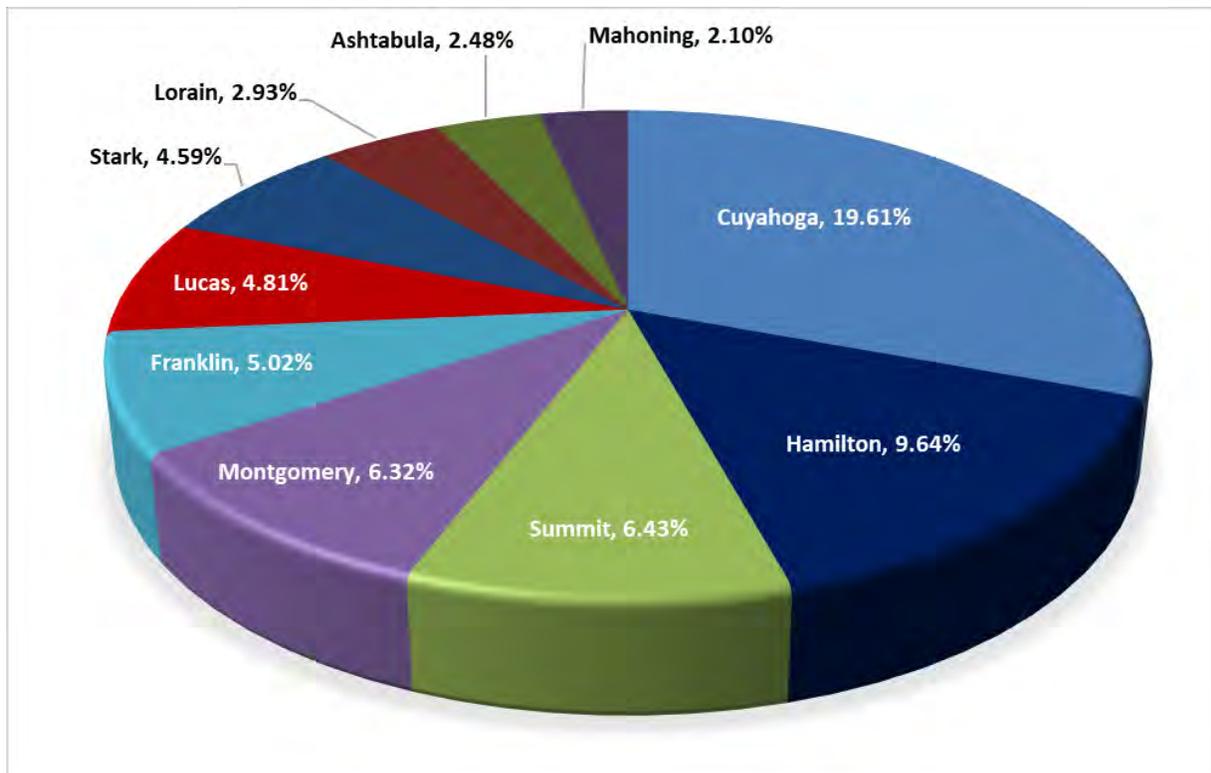

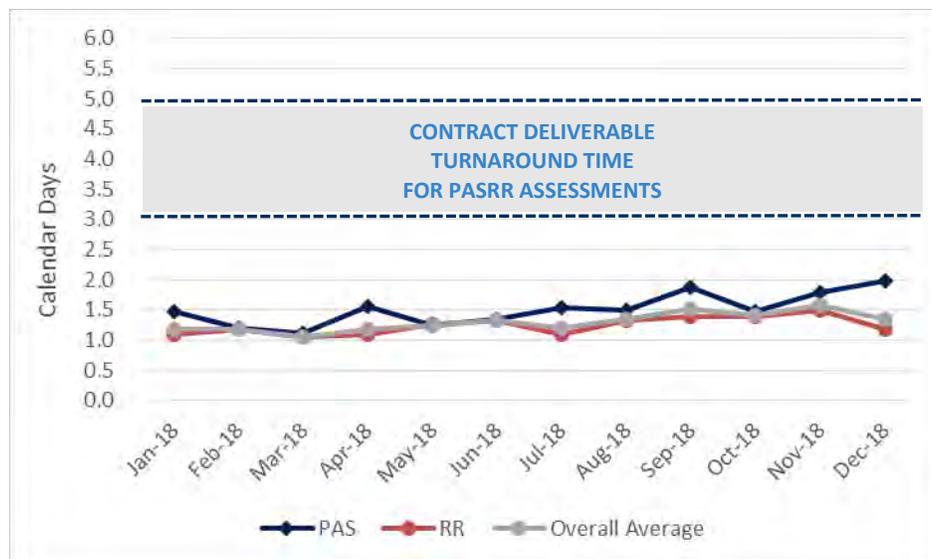
Figure III d – Overall % of Completed Reviews

The contract deliverable for Turnaround Time (TAT) on PASRR non-expedited assessments is 3 to 5 calendar days. In 2018, KEPRO exceeded the contract deliverable. This does not include cases with dual MI & DD diagnoses.

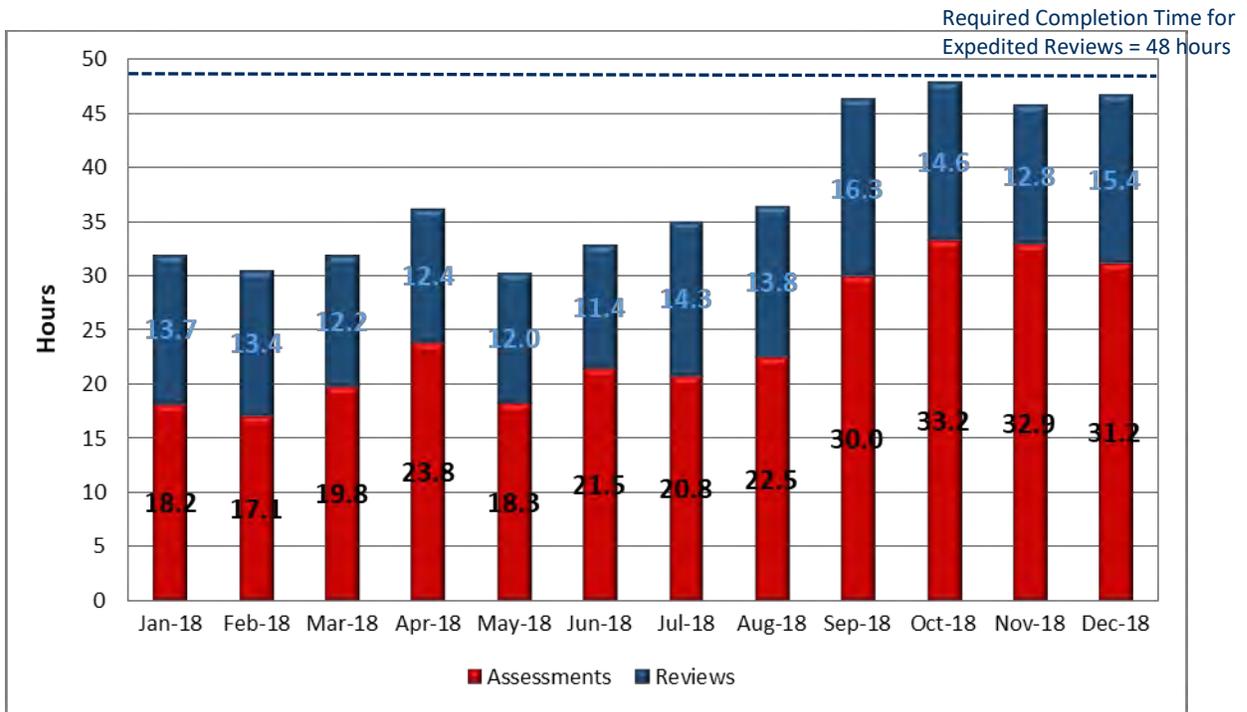
Figure IVa – KEPRO Turnaround Times for Non-Expedited Reviews 2018

As shown below in figure IVb the TAT for Expedited determinations was within the State mandated limit of 48 hours. This does not include cases with dual MI & DD diagnoses.

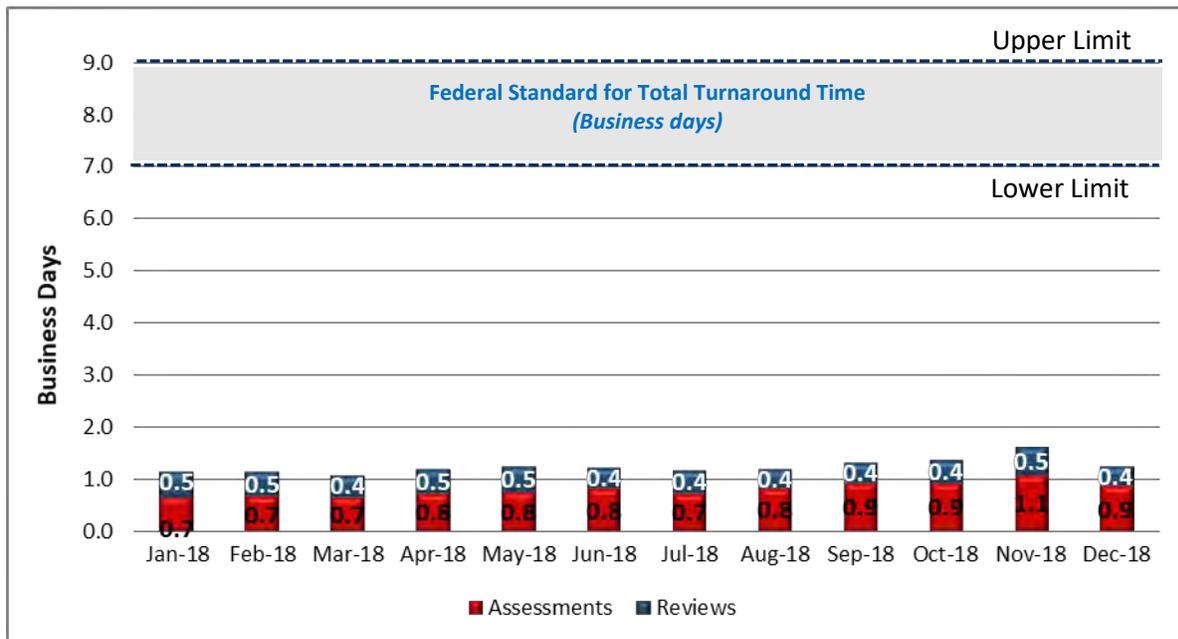
Figure IVb – KEPRO and Ohio Turnaround Times for Expedited Reviews

Figure IVc displays the TAT for all reviews compared to the National Standard of 7-9 business days. Ohio exceeded the National Standard with an average overall turnaround of 1.3 business days during 2018. This does not include cases with dual MI & DD diagnoses.
