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RESIDENTIAL STATE SUPPLEMENT

Provides financial assistance to adults with a disability who can live in eligible living arrangements (i.e., Class Two Residential Facilities or Adult Care Facilities).

Eligibility Criteria:

- Eligible for or enrolled in Medicaid; and
- Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) Receiving Social Security, Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Supplemental .

Eligible individuals may have a monthly income up to \$1,300 and up to \$2,000 in assets*.

Funds May Cover:

- Accommodations
- Supervision
- Personal Care Services

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Provides financial assistance to adults with a behavioral health diagnosis to transition from nursing homes to sustainable community living.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrolled in Medicaid;
- Presents with behavioral health diagnosis (includes mental illness or substance use disorders); and
- Currently receives treatment in a nursing home and wishes to transition to the community.

Funds May Cover:

- Short-term housing assistance;
- One-time payment of utility arrears;
- Supplemental independent living assistance (such as homemaker/personal care services or peer recovery support services); and
- Other needs to support independent living in the community.

Application Checklist. Forms must be submitted to OhioMHAS before the resident or client discharges from the nursing home.
