
Web-based Reporting Facility

- Collects Treatment Episode Information
 - Originally known as Treatment Episode Data Set (TEDS)
 - Includes SAMHSA National Outcome Measures (NOMs)
 - Treatment Episodes Defined by:
 - Admission, Transfer, Discharge Records (SUD)
 - Admission, Annual Update, Discharge Records (MH)
- MH-TEDS required by SAMHSA's Substance Abuse and Prevention Treatment (SAPT) and Mental Health Block Grant (MHBG)
 - **SAPT & MHBG = \$85,000,000**

National Outcome Measures (NOMs)

Collected at Admission, Annual Update and/or Discharge

- Employment Status
- Educational Status
- Living Arrangement
- Criminal Justice Involvement
- Social Connectedness (SUD)
 - Self-Help Program Participation



Ohio's Outcomes can be compared to other states.

Other BioPsychoSocial Information

- Smoking Status
- Military Status
- Referral Source
- Pregnancy Status
- Primary Source of income
- Diagnosis
- Special Populations, e.g., nonconforming gender identity, trauma history, deaf/hard-of-hearing
- Discharge Reason

Who Reports?

Providers certified or licensed by OhioMHAS to provide behavioral health services are required under [ORC 5119.61](#) and [OAC 5122-28-04](#) to report information in OBHIS.

... The department shall collect information about services delivered and persons served as required for reporting and evaluation relating to state and federal funds expended for such purposes.



From Whom is Information Collected?

Any client admitted to treatment for a mental health condition and/or substance use disorder whose services are payed in whole or in part with public dollars:

- Medicaid
- ADAMHS Board
- OhioMHAS





How Data Are Reported

- OBHIS users can enter records into the application two ways:
 - Manually through an online data entry template
 - Providers with annual caseloads of 500 or less typically chose this option
 - This requires a dedicated data entry staff
 - Semi-automatically through a batch upload feature
 - Providers with annual caseloads of 500 or more should consider this option
 - Data extracted from the agency's information system or EHR is formatted into a flat file and uploaded
 - Providers will need to work with IT staff or EHR vendor to implement batch reporting



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Reporting Records in OBHIS Requires Planning

- Identify Organizational Staff to act as OBHIS Provider Administrator
 - Authorizes other staff access to the system
 - Maintains the Provider Set-up in the application
 - Runs performance reports
- Decide how Organization will manage data flow
 - Data can be compiled manually, using paper forms
 - Data can be extracted from agency's information system or EHR



- OhioMHAS staff are available to help with implementation planning.
- Implementation Tips are available on OBHIS website.

Implementation

- All users must set up an OH|ID account
- Administrator Providers need to be identified and need to request access to OBHIS production by September 15, 2020
- Any user can request access to the test site prior to October 1, 2020
- All other users can request access to the OBHIS production on or after September 15, 2020
- October 1, 2020 – Go-live date for OBHIS. OHBH will no longer be used. All Active client data will be migrated to the new system



OBHIS Reports

- Providers and Boards can access an application with reports for
 - Management of OBHIS Records
 - Descriptions of Client Characteristics
 - Client Outcomes (NOMS)
- Providers can access reports with client-level data (detail reports)
- Boards can only access summary reports (no client-level data)

What to do now and timing of go-live:

- Request access to the OBHIS Test site
- September 15 – October 1: begin granting OBHIS application access to staff members
- October 1st: complete Provider Setup in OBHIS production; (OHBH will no longer be available)
