## 2016 ECS Changes [BH Section5]

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## Standard 5.A.16.

- Standard 5.A.16. has been modified slightly to clarify that training in the use of positive interventions is provided to personnel who provide services to persons served.

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## Standard 5.A.16.

- Note in the Intent for Standard 5.A.16. *This standard applies even if the program/service does not use behavioral change approaches as identified in Standard 5.A.14.*

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## Standard 5.A.17.c.(2)

- In Standard 5.A.17., element c.(2) has been modified; “staff members” was changed to *service personnel* to clarify that training is provided to personnel who provide services to persons served.

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## Standard 5.A.19.

- Standard 5.A.19. has been revised for clarity; requirements are not changed.

## Standard 5.A.19.

- 5.A.19. When services are provided to a person placed in services through an arrangement with a court or criminal justice system, the organization:
  - a. Provides information to the person served concerning the relationship between the criminal justice entity and the organization.

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## Standard 5.A.19. *continued*

- b. Maintains, when and as required by governmental authorities, a record of the person's criminal history.
- c. Coordinates services with other systems, as needed and/or required.

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## Standard 5.E.4.

- Standard 5.E.4. has been modified to clarify that the medication review may be conducted by either a physician or a pharmacist.

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## Standard 5.E.5.

- In Standard 5.E.5., elements a.–c. have been changed to add *if applicable*, and the Intent statement for this standard was modified to clarify that if the program does not have any role in medication purchase, transportation, or off-site use by persons served, it is not required to have written procedures for these.

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## Standard 5.E.5.

- 5.E.5. An organization that manages medications for persons served implements written procedures that address:
  - a. Purchase, **if applicable**, including processes for handling medication shortages on weekends.
  - b. Transportation and delivery, **if applicable**.
  - c. Off-site use, **if applicable**.

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## 5.F. Children & Adolescents

- The stem of Standard 5.F.1. was revised slightly for clarity to add ***as relevant to the scope of services***.
- The stem of Standard 5.F.7. was revised slightly for clarity to add ***as appropriate to the scope of services***.

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## 5.F. Children & Adolescents

- Previous Standard 5.F.8. has been deleted as redundant to 5.F.7.

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## 5.F. Children & Adolescents

- In Standard 5.F.9. (previously 5.F.10.) previous element k. “Family systems theory” has been deleted.

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## 5.G. Child & Youth Services

- The stems of Standards 5.G.1. and 5.G.7. were revised slightly for clarity to add ***as appropriate to the scope of services.***

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## 5.G. Child & Youth Services

- In Standard 5.G.10. the word *service* was added to clarify that training is provided to personnel who provide services, and previous element k. “Family systems theory” has been deleted.

## 5.I. Community Integration

- Previous Standards 5.I.7. and 5.I.8. have been deleted.
