


Benzodiazepine Doses Dispensed per Capita

Map Information:

This map displays the number of prescription benzodiazepine doses dispensed per capita in each county in 2011. Per capita measures are based on county population.

The 2011 statewide average doses dispensed per capita was 25.6. The counties with the highest numbers of dispensed doses per capita were Guernsey county (59.5), Muskingum county (51.9), and Adams county, (51.1). The counties with the lowest numbers of dispensed doses per capita were Holmes county, (13.1), Union county (14.4), Delaware county (14.4), and Geauga county (14.6).

Per capita rates are based on oral solids.

County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
