


Benzodiazepine Doses Dispensed per Patient

Ohio's Automated Rx Reporting System - 2011

Map Information:

This map displays the number of prescription benzodiazepine doses dispensed per patient in each county in 2011. Per patient measures are based on the number of individuals in the county who received benzodiazepine prescriptions.

The 2011 statewide average doses dispensed per patient was 297.7. The counties with the highest numbers of dispensed doses per patient were Lawrence county (404.4), Brown county (397.9), and Ross county (389.8). The counties with the lowest numbers of dispensed doses per patient were Ashland county, (207.9), Delaware county (208.8), and Geauga county (216.0).

Per patient rates are based on oral solids.

County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
