


Treatment for Alcohol Use Disorder

Percentage of clients



Map Information:

This map represents the percentage of unduplicated clients with a primary diagnosis of alcohol use disorder (AUD) served in each county during SFY 2011. The average rate of clients with a primary diagnosis of AUD across counties was 37.3%. The highest rates were found in Coshocton county (69.6%), Tuscarawas county (64.1%), and Morgan county (63.1%). The lowest rates were found in Scioto county (10.3%), Lawrence county (16.3%), and Adams county (18.3%). All counties reported 25 or more clients. Counties with 25-49 clients are signified by diagonal lines. County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
