


Treatment for Opiate Use Disorder

Map Information:

This map represents the percentage of unduplicated clients with a primary diagnosis of opiate use disorder (OUD) served in each county during SFY 2011. The average rate of clients with a primary diagnosis of OUD across counties was 24.6%. The highest rates were found in Scioto county (71.0%), Lawrence county (60.4%), and Pike county (53.2%). The lowest rates were found in Tuscarawas county (7.0%), Darke county (10.2%), and Allen county (12.6%). Counties that reported fewer than 25 clients are signified by gray, and no rate is given. Counties with 25-49 clients are signified by diagonal lines. County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
