


# Benzodiazepine Doses Dispensed per Patient

## Map Information:

This map displays the number of prescription benzodiazepine doses dispensed per patient in each county in 2013. Per patient measures are based on the number of individuals in the county who received benzodiazepine prescriptions.

The 2013 statewide average doses dispensed per patient was 298.9. The counties with the highest numbers of dispensed doses per patient were Lawrence county (425.8), Ross county (407.7), and Muskingum county, (405.1). The counties with the lowest numbers of dispensed doses per patient were Delaware county, (204.5), Geauga county (214.0), and Ashland county (221.3).

Per patient rates are based on oral solids.

County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
