


Prescription Opioid Doses Dispensed per Capita

Ohio's Automated Rx Reporting System - 2016

Map Information:

This map displays the number of prescription opioid doses dispensed per capita in each county in 2016. Per capita measures are based on county population.

The 2016 statewide average doses dispensed per capita was 55.1. The counties with the highest numbers of dispensed doses per capita were Jackson county (98.6), Adams county (95.9), and Perry county (91.9). The counties with the lowest numbers of dispensed doses per capita were Holmes county, (18.6), Geauga county (35.3), Putnam county (35.8), and Mercer county (36.0).

Per capita rates are based on oral solids, sublingual films, and transdermal patches. All opioid solutions are excluded from the analyses.

County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
