


Treatment for Cannabis Use Disorder

Percentage of clients




Map Information:

This map represents the percentage of unduplicated clients with a primary diagnosis of cannabis use disorder (CUD) served in each county during SFY 2016. The average rate of clients with a primary diagnosis of CUD across counties was 17.2%. The highest rates were found in Cuyahoga county (27.4%), Lorain county (22.5%), and Muskingum county (22.3%). The lowest rates were found in Scioto county (4.8%), Hardin county (5.0%), and Pickaway county (7.8%).

Counties that reported fewer than 25 clients are signified by gray, and no rate is given. Counties with 25-49 clients are signified by diagonal lines.

County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
