


Treatment for Cocaine Use Disorder

Map Information:

This map represents the percentage of unduplicated clients with a primary diagnosis of cocaine use disorder (CUD) served in each county during SFY 2016. The average rate of clients with a primary diagnosis of CUD across counties was 5.0%. The highest rates were found in Hancock county (8.1%), Cuyahoga county (7.6%), and Clark county (6.9%). The lowest rates were found in Ashtabula county (1.8%), Licking county (2.2%), and Ross county (2.2%).

Many counties had fewer than 25 clients with a primary diagnosis of CUD; these counties are signified by gray, and no rate is given. Counties with 25-49 clients are signified by diagonal lines. County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
