


Benzodiazepine Doses Dispensed per Capita

Map Information:

This map displays the number of prescription benzodiazepine doses dispensed per capita in each county in 2017. Per capita measures are based on county population.

The 2017 statewide average benzodiazepine doses dispensed per capita was 20.2. The counties with the highest numbers of dispensed doses per capita were Muskingum county (45.3), Guernsey county (42.4), and Ross county (39.2). The counties with the lowest numbers of dispensed doses per capita were Holmes county, (11.2), Williams county (12.6), Delaware county (12.8), and Darke county (12.8).

Per capita rates are based on oral solids.

County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
