


# Benzodiazepine Doses Dispensed per Patient

Ohio's Automated Rx Reporting System - 2017

## Map Information:

This map displays the number of prescription benzodiazepine doses dispensed per patient in each county in 2017. Per patient measures are based on the number of individuals in the county who received benzodiazepine prescriptions.

The 2017 statewide average benzodiazepine doses dispensed per patient was 272.7. The counties with the highest numbers of dispensed doses per patient were Ross county (399.5), Muskingum county (386.3), and Scioto county (386.2). The counties with the lowest numbers of dispensed doses per patient were Delaware county, (187.6), Geauga county (200.3), and Williams county (201.6).

Per patient rates are based on oral solids.

County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
