


Prescription Opioid Doses Dispensed per Capita

Map Information:

This map displays the number of prescription opioid doses dispensed per capita in each county in 2017. Per capita measures are based on county population.

The 2017 statewide average opioid doses dispensed per capita was 49.3. The counties with the highest numbers of dispensed doses per capita were Adams county (92.8), Vinton county (86.8), and Jackson county, (86.3). The counties with the lowest numbers of dispensed doses per capita were Holmes county, (16.6), Geauga county (31.3), and Ashland county (32.9). Per capita rates are based on oral solids, sublingual films, and transdermal patches. All opioid solutions are excluded from the analyses.

County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
