


# Medication Assisted Treatment in Ohio

OARRS - Doses per 100 people in 2012

## Map Information:

This map represents county-level data on drugs commonly used in medication assisted treatment (MAT). It presents MAT doses per 100 people for drugs like buprenorphine, Suboxone® and Subutex®. In 2012, counties with the highest MAT doses per 100 people were Gallia (550.7), Scioto (435.2) and Jackson (391.8). Counties with the lowest MAT doses per 100 people were Mercer (12.9), Darke (16.0) and Holmes (16.3). All buprenorphine solutions are excluded from the analyses. Additionally, Butrans is excluded because it is primarily used for pain management and not MAT.

Note: Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Boards have black borders, and counties have white borders. Borders are black in cases where ADAMHS boards and counties have the same borders.
