Map Information:

This map displays the number of prescription benzodiazepine doses dispensed per capita in each county in 2019. Per capita measures are based on county population.

The 2019 statewide average benzodiazepine doses dispensed per capita was 15.7. The counties with the highest numbers of dispensed doses per capita were Muskingum county (35.7), Guernsey county (32.1), and Adams county (31.0). The counties with the lowest numbers of dispensed doses per capita were Ashland county, (8.5), Holmes county (8.8), and Williams county (9.7).

Per capita rates are based on oral solids.

County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
