


Treatment for Cannabis Use Disorder

Percentage of Unduplicated Clients in SFY 2017

Map Information:

This map represents the percentage of unduplicated clients with a primary diagnosis of cannabis use disorder (CUD) served in each county during SFY 2017. The average rate of clients with a primary diagnosis of CUD across counties was 17.0%. The highest rates were found in Holmes county (26.9%), Cuyahoga county (24.4%), and Hocking county (23.4%). The lowest rates were found in Scioto county (5.3%), Lawrence county (6.1%), and Pike county (9.2%). Counties that reported fewer than 25 clients are signified by gray, and no rate is given. Counties with 25-49 clients are signified by diagonal lines. County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
